### **TOTAL CHAOS EQUIPPED TOYOTA RACE TRUCK WINS VORRA LOVELOCK 250**

Michael Hardesty, aka "Farmboy" to the Locos Mocos crew, took the checkered flag on Saturday June 23, 2007 at the 3rd race of the 2007 VORRA Off Road Racing series which was held in Lovelock, Nevada. 1st off the line in class 7 competing against 4 class 7 trucks and against 35 cars and trucks overall. Going into the Lovelock 250 as the class 7 points leader and overall series points leader, the pressure was on "Farmboy" to stay ahead of the pack and win the race. For his friends, family and sponsors, Mike did just that with a 1st place finish in class 7 and a top 10 finish overall.

After the race Mike stated, "I was 1st off line in my class and nobody ever caught me. I was to the floor the whole entire race. I never lifted! I thought for sure the Ranger and V6 Toyota had me beat on power." Well his driving style proved to pay off since "Farmboy" leads the VORRA overall point standings after 3 races and 3 first place finishes! Hardesty is set to compete in the Southern California MDR Off Road series at the August 2007 night race.

Mike's race truck is equipped with TC's 84-95 2wd lift spindle uniball kit that was originally purchased in 8/2004 and still runs the original upper and lower control arms.
