

ROUND 3 Results for Team DNF Racing in the Stadium Series

DNF Racing drivers Dan Vance and Clifford Murray swept with a one, two finish in round 3 of the Mickey Thompson Kalgard SXS Stadium Series at Perris Auto Speedway. Bad weather forced the cancellation of the practice session for drivers to get comfortable on the newly designed track Friday night. Without the ability to practice, all drivers were now on a 100% even playing field during the first practice session on Saturday before the race. "The water truck over watered the track prior to the race day practice session on Saturday and the track turned into a swamp. Trucks were spun out all over the track" said Vance. This was the first race Vance was running the newly released Goodyear Wrangler Kevlar MTR mud tires on the truck. Vance stated after the practice session, "The new style of tires on the truck performed so well we managed to lap the field twice during practice!"

The qualifying round had the track much drier and Vance battled door to door with the competition for the first qualifying spot. After a very tight battle with the fastest competition team DNF has faced to date, Vance managed to edge the next fastest competitor by five hundredths of a second to score the number one qualifying position for the main event.

Although Vance managed to once again score the top qualifying spot, he was not satisfied. His mission was to protect his undefeated winning streak that he has held out of the reach of the competition so far this season in the series. Vance strapped in one of his veteran co drivers, Miguel "Loco" Jones for this round to make sure every base was covered to give him the best chance at remaining undefeated. When the green flag dropped it was hammer down and don't look back. "We went into turn one a bit hot and put the truck up high on two wheels for a few seconds! Once it landed back on all four's it was all business again and we managed to pull away from the field." Round 3 resulted with a lot of carnage to the highly competitive field, but Vance and Murray managed to escape it for podium finishes, scoring first and second place for Team DNF Racing. Round 4 should be interesting as Vance has declared that, "I am going to do whatever it takes to remain undefeated for all eight rounds of the series this season. I dare the competition to try and take that away from me!"
