

Round 5 M4SX



Undefeated M4SX 1450 class driver Dan Vance walks away with \$500 in cash & prizes after round 5 of the M4SX series presented by Mickey Thompson & KalGard at Perris Auto Speedway. The largest field of the season showed up for battle at the speedway. 9 trucks were on hand for first practice to test their set up and skills. After a timed 2nd practice for starting order, the main event included 8 drivers that took the rolling green headed toward the first right hand 180 degree corner in a double file start. The main event did not lack door banging action in the tight corners.

The 1st and 2nd place qualifiers of Kevin McMurray and Dan Vance were lined up in the rear of the pack to add to the action. In the first corner the series leader Dan Vance had a target on his driver door. Three wide into the right hander was a tight fit but Vance had his eyes set on the back stretch and having the lead by then. Vance passed 5 drivers in the first 4 corners of the first lap. With an 18 lap main event and a mandatory ½ way competition yellow scheduled, the format tightened the gap Vance had built ½ way through the race. This narrowed the gap between Vance and Cannon and on the second restart.

With 9 laps to go the drivers put on one heck of a show handing the lead from one corner to the next. Creative line choice by both drivers kept the racing clean and close! In the end Vance edged Cannon by a few trucks lengths for the win and remains undefeated for the M4SX series.
