**June 26, 2006** - 5 TOTAL CHAOS equipped Toyota trucks conquer the Mojave Desert Racing McKenzie's 400 in Class 1450. Leading the charge for Team CHAOS and chasing the overall points standings for MDR, Matt Helton took TC's prototype Gen 3 Caddy kit to the podium with a solid second place finish. Mike Hardesty, aka "Farmboy" hit the highway driving his race truck to Lucerne from Yearington Nevada to compete in this event. Hardesty started the race with 21 other drivers and finished an impressive 5<sup>th</sup> place. Right after the race "Farmboy" hopped in his street legal *race truck* loaded with spare parts and gear, and drove the truck home on the highway after completing the entire 200 mile race and logging 1- 50 mile prerun lap. " *Oh what a feeling. TOYOTA!* "

Brian Metcho, AJ Steeber and Mike Belcher also competed in the event and tackled the race course in their TOTAL CHAOS Fabrication suspension equipped race trucks. Metcho and Helton have been testing the new Gen 3 Caddy systems this season and have logged over 1000 off road miles combined. TC is going to offer the system to the public at the end of summer. Belcher competed with TC's 1995.5-2004 Tacoma 4wd long travel system with Hardesty and Steeber racing on the 86-95 2wd uniball kits.

22 trucks started the race in Class 1450 and TC drivers finished in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, & 15<sup>th</sup> place.

Pro driver Dan Vance also competed in the race however transmission failure expired the truck at mile marker 60 and ended the day early.
