

Heim Steering Kit Installation PT# 96098 (96-02 4Runner), PT# 96099 (96-04 Tacoma) PT# 97099 (00-06 Tundra)

Factory manual is recommended for removal and re-installation of all factory components.

Stock Tie Rod Removal

- 1. Put truck on jack stands, remove front wheels.
- 2. Remove cotter pins from tie rod ends.
- 3. Remove tie rods.
- 4. Remove lower ball joints and clean surface for welding.

Installation of Heim Steering Kit

- 1. (Tacoma only pt# 96099) Press in tapered sleeve to lower ball joint. (Tundra pt# 97099 / 4Runner pt# 96098) Drill out tie rod hole to 5/8". A drill press is preferable and should be done by an experienced technician or machine shop.
- 2. Sand surface on ball joint for welding of gusset.
- 3. Bolt heim joint and gusset to lower ball joint for mock up and then tack weld gusset to the ball joint.
- 4. Remove heim joint and fully weld gusset to ball joint.
- 5. Bolt and torque ball joint to spindle.
- 6. Bolt and torque ball joint to lower arm and install new cotter pin.
- 7. Assemble heim w/ jam nut and misalignment spacers to ball joint.
- 8. Torque 5/8" bolt to 90ft lbs.
- 9. Thread new tie rods to steering rack and onto heim.
- 10. Bolt wheels back on vehicle and torque.
- 11. Adjust alignment and tighten jam nuts.
